AUGUST TREASURER'S REPORT

General Fund: Previous statement balance as of June 23, 2022 was \$21,984.97. Revenue Received were \$70,434.00 for USDA Treasury. Expenses Cleared were \$70,434.00 for USDA Treasury, \$100.00 for Willets, Baird & CO., PLC, \$3,668.22 for Titan Machinery, \$\$383.83 for Titan Machinery. Revenue Presented were \$15,648.10 for City of Osceola FY 2022-23 Sponsorship Contributions, \$14,236.72 for SIRWA FY 2022-23 Sponsorship Contributions, \$16,445.87 for Osceola Water Works FY 2022-23 Sponsorship Contributions. Expenses presented for payment was \$238.00 for Friday Insurance Agency INC. Resulting in a balance of \$63,925.61 for August 4, 2022.

Special Account: Previous statement balance as of June 23, 2022 was \$35,671.18. Revenue received was \$9.68 for June 2022 interest. No Expenses Cleared. No revenue was presented for deposit. No Expenses were presented for payment. Resulting in a balance of \$35,680.86 for August 4, 2022.

LOSST 2008 Checking Account: Previous statement balance as of June 23, 2022 was \$4,951.98. Revenue received was \$2,136.39 for Local Option Sales Tax Woodburn, \$1.50 for June 2022 interest. Expenses Cleared were \$1,278.58 for Savage Excavating, \$3,437.58 for Savage Excavating. Revenues presented \$2,136.39 for Woodburn Local Option Sales Tax. No Expenses were presented for payment. Resulting in a balance of \$4,510.10 for August 4, 2022.

LOSST 2009 Checking Account: Previous statement balance as of June 23, 2022 was \$162,086.72. Revenue received was \$70,434.00 for USDA Treasury transfer from General Account, and \$50.87for June 2022 interest. Expenses Cleared were \$36,000.00 for HDR Engineering, \$90,000.00 for HDR Engineering. Revenue presented was \$541,797.19 for City of Osceola-Local Option Sales Tax. Expenses presented for payment were \$11,250.00 Osceola Water Works, \$27,500 CPI, LLC, and \$134.65 for CPI, LLC. Resulting in a balance of \$609,484.13 as of August 4, 2022.

LOSST 2010 Preferred Direct Savings Account: Previous statement balance as of June 23, 2022 was \$111,252.29. Revenue received was \$10,541.01 for City of Murray-Local Option Sales Tax, \$8,960.25 for City of Murray-Local Option Sales Tax, \$34.15 June, 2022 interest. No Expenses Cleared. Revenues presented \$10,541.01 Murray Local Option Sales Tax, \$2,577.34 for Murray Local Option Sales Tax. No Expenses were presented for payment. Resulting in a balance of \$143,906.05 for August 4, 2022.

Dave Beck talked about a recent SIRWA letter that was received, and notes SIRWA's decision is to fully support the project moving forward.

Ty Wheeler had to excuse himself at 10:15 am from the meeting due to another meeting that was needing his attendance. Chairperson, Ty Wheeler gave Vice Chair Brandon Patterson to lead the rest of the meeting.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT UPDATE

Dave Beck updated the commission on a letter that was recently sent to Tim Dunbar regarding land easement questions.

CCRC recently hosted a Prairie walk on July 20th, there was an amazing turn out with around 40 people that showed up.
