TREASURER'S REPORT

General Fund: Previous cash balance as of July 15, 2021 was \$2,933.08. No revenue was received. Bill presented for payment was \$81.84 Creston Publishing for publication of June meeting minutes [ck#1477]. Resulting in a cash balance of \$2,851.24 for August 19, 2021.

Special Account: Previous cash balance as of July 15, 2021 was \$19,518.17. Revenue received was \$11.29 for July 2021 interest. Bill presented for payment was \$18,000.00 HDR for Task Order #9-Watershed Plan Update [ck#1028]. Resulting in a cash balance of \$1,529.46 for August 19, 2021.

LOSST 2008 Checking Account: Previous cash balance as of July 15, 2021 was \$6,200.70. Revenue received was \$2,902.31 City of Woodburn for April 2021 sales tax and \$2.07 for July interest. No bills were presented for payment. Resulting in a cash balance of \$9,105.08 for August 19, 2021.

LOSST 2009 Checking Account: Previous cash balance as of July 15, 2021 was \$6,661.57. Revenue received was \$1.97 for July 2021 interest. Bill presented for payment was \$2,300.50 Ahlers and Cooney, P.C. for Hofbauer condemnation appeal [ck#1358]. Resulting in a cash balance of \$4,363.04 for August 19, 2021.

LOSST 2010 Preferred Direct Savings Account: Previous cash balance as of July 15, 2021 was \$3,105.50. Revenue received was \$4.73 for July 2021 interest and \$11,739.89 City of Murray for June 2021 sales tax. No bills were presented for payment. Resulting in a cash balance of \$14,850.12 for August 19, 2021.

NEW BUSINESS AND CONTINUING BUSINESS

MOWING OF HAY GROUND

Dave Beck, CPI, reported that he had identified 65 acres of additional hay ground that could be mowed by Bud Jones and, rather than asking Jones for additional dollars, he negotiated with Jones to complete mowing for the CCRC. Beck also suggested that the CCRC allow Jones to continue mowing the designated hay ground areas in future years.

PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING -CLARKE COUNTY WFPO PROGRAM WATERSHED PROJECT

Mark Duben, HDR, presented a power point presentation explaining the work being done to update the CCRC's watershed plan. Part of the process is to inform federal, state, and local agencies, tribes and local citizens of the project and also to allow them to provide information and comment on the project. The

updated watershed plan will identify problems in the watershed and propose possible alternatives to alleviate the problems. The alternatives that HDR will look at are: building a dam at site 4B (this is the current location of the dam), a pipeline to Des Moines, doing nothing and looking at another potential dam site that is north of site 4B.

Dubin opened the discussion for public comment. There were no comments made by those in attendance of the meeting.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT UPDATE

Dave Beck reported that he has been mowing and evaluating the Commission's prairie seeding areas. Upcoming projects Beck would like to work on are boundary fencing on the Robins and Hofbauer tracts. Beck will be sending a letter to schedule the check out for John Snyder, whose lease expires September 1.
