HDR REPORT

Mark Duben with HDR Engineering was not able to attend the meeting due to having to attend another meeting in Iowa City. Dave Beck with CPI provided an on behalf of Mark Duben, Dave stated HDR is pulling their team together to complete the environmental review work for the updated plan. Dave Beck and HDR staff met with NRCS on October 12th, to review the progress on the plan update and get some answer to questions on the environmental work. He stated the agreement we initially had with NRCS

went through December 31, 2022. However, we are going to have to request an extension because all work on the plan update will not be completed. Dave Beck is working on getting a draft request for the extension request put together, and will have this done by early November.

Commissioner William Trickey made a motion to authorize Ty Wheeler to sign on behalf of the commission to extend NRCS agreement for another 12 months. Commissioner Denise Arnold seconded the motion.

DISCUSSION ON PROJECT FUNDING

Ty Wheeler informed the commission that a request to the state has been submitted for funding and the request is still being currently reviewed.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT UPDATE

Dave Beck gave an update regarding the Dudney Fencing invoice, the estimate that was approved was less than the invoice received but states additional braces were necessary due to unusual steep topography and irregular boundary. Dave Beck said the fence was completed on the west property fence line on Hofbauer Tract.

Commissioner Sue Wilder made a motion to authorize payment to Dudney Fencing in the amount of \$10,970.00. Commissioner Jeff Rice seconded the motion. Motion carried on roll call vote:
